

Recent Steps in STPUD Water Supply Journey

A. January 2020: Submit Amended Application No. A023393 and exhibits to the SWRCB




B. Fall 2023: Receive request from SWRCB for "re-noticing" of application

- C. February 2024: Hold Board Workshop on Surface Water Rights
- D. April 2024: Staff Report "Options for Water Supply Augmentation"

Benefits of Surface Water


- 1. Diversify Water Supply: Currently 100% Groundwater
- 2. Surface Water higher "priority" than Groundwater
- 3. Broader Water Security
- 4. Replace Contaminated Groundwater: PCE, arsenic, uranium
- 5. Supplement Low-Yield Groundwater Wells
- 6. Address Increased Regulation: **PFAS**
- Avoid Costly and Otherwise Unnecessary Distribution System Upgrades
- 8. Surface Water more "scalable" than Groundwater
- 9. Leverage Availability of an Exceptionally Clean Surface Water Source (Lake Tahoe)

Next Steps in STPUD Water Supply Journey

- 1. Submit Change Petition to the SWRCB for Application No. A023933 (by April 30, 2024)
- 2. Proceed with Water Supply Master Plan
 - Refine scope (Groundwater and Surface Water)
 - Issue RFP for Technical Support (by June 2024)
 - Select Consultant and bring proposal to Board for consideration
- 3. Prepare for Public Notice of Surface Water Rights application
 - Receive response from SWRCB on Change Petition, with direction for next steps (Noticing and CEQA)
 - Lead Public Outreach in advance of SWRCB Public Notice
 - Respond to comments/protests filed in response to SWRCB Public Notice
- 4. Develop Programmatic CEQA (for Water Supply MP and SW Rights Application)
 - Refine scope based on results of Water Supply Master Plan and SWRCB Public Notice
 - Work with Technical and Legal Consultants to prepare proposal for Board consideration
 - Prepare Draft CEQA: post, receive/respond to comments and hold hearing to adopt
- 5. SWRCB Issues Permit

Annually: Report to State on use of SW (and GW in lieu of SW)
