engineering STAFF REPORT (as of August 9, 2021)

CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

- a. Luther Pass Tank No. 2 and Site Valving (Contractor: TNT Industrial)
 - Tank No. 2 reconstruction continues
 - Exterior coating underway
 - Roof install begins August 24
 - New sleeve valve installed July 14
 - Holding pressure
 - Flow test after Tank No. 2 in service
- b. Secondary Clarifier No. 3 Rehabilitation Project (Contractor: TNT Industrial)
 - Mechanism foundation poured August 10
 - Next concrete pour ties foundation to floor
 - Return Activated Sludge (RAS) pipe installed and encased below clarifier slab
 - Not yet connected to existing RAS
 - Mechanism installation scheduled for early September

- c. Rocky 1 Waterline Replacement Project (Contractor: Haen)
 - Rocky Waterline installation underway
 - Progress is slow due to excessive rock
 - Staff is considering postponing Stewart and Mackedie work to 2022
- d. Keller Heavenly Phase 1 Project (Contractor: White Rock)
 - Tank foundation poured August 10
 - Rock slope stabilization to commence late August
 - Saddle Pressure Regulating Valve (PRV) excavated
 - Mostly rock
 - Sherman Way Waterline nearing completion
 - Testing and disinfection week of August 16
- e. Keller Heavenly Phase 2 Project (Contractor: White Rock)
 - Board awarded Project on July 15
 - Contract execution underway
- f. Blower Generator, Secondary Clarifiers No.'s 1 and 2, and Tank Backup Power (Contractor: Vinciguerra))
 - Partial Stop Notice still in effect pending approval from FEMA for Blower Generator
 - Staff is continuing to work with contractor to value engineer Tank Backup Power scope
 - Secondary Clarifiers funding approved by State Revolving fund (SRF)
 - Contract in development
 - FEMA application was rejected
 - Staff preparing Contract Change Order for extra work process for FEMA requirements
- g. Diamond Valley Ranch (DVR) Siphon Repair (Contractor: Christian Brothers Lining)
 - Liner installation complete
 - Except for testing of manway
 - Postponed for fire response
- h. Tank Coatings Touchup Project (Contractor: Topline Engineers)
 - Contractor began work at Angora Tank on August 9
 - Touchup work at Lookout and Forest Mountain will follow in September
- i. Tahoe Keys Pump Station (Contractor: T&S Construction)
 - Contract execution is underway
 - Expect to issue Notice to Proceed by end of August
 - Staff is preparing project permit application for TRPA and City Encroachment Permit

PLANNING/DESIGN

- a. Groundwater Management Planning
 - Staff met with representatives from Tahoe Keys on July 29 to discuss their concepts for a
 potential Prop 1 Implementation Grant application to provide more supply and address
 PCE contamination at Tahoe Keys Property Owners Association (TKPOA) wells
 - Groundwater Management Plan Update
 - Staff is meeting this week with Desert Research Institute (DRI) to discuss their progress with the Groundwater Management Plan Update
 - Staff expects to have full document compiled by end of September for routing to Stakeholder's Advisory Group SAG for comment

- b. Paloma Well Rehabilitation (Consultant: Domenichelli)
 - On July 15, Board approved staff to negotiate scope and price with Zim Industries
 - Staff is evaluating the new scope options and prices
 - Expects to bring the Board a recommendation for a Contract on August 19
- c. Upper Truckee Pump Station Rehabilitation (Consultant: Carollo)
 - State requested a supplemental map of cultural resources for SRF Loan application
 - Staff provided it to state first week of August
- d. Keller-Heavenly Phase 3 Project (Consultant: Farr West)
 - Consultant preparing proposal for final design and bid documents
 - Keller Booster Improvements being added to design scope using remaining SRF Loan
- e. Blower System Improvements Design (Consultant: Carollo)
 - Staff is reviewing proposal from Carollo
 - Expect to bring to Board on September 2
- f. Tallac Creek Crossing (Consultant: NHC)
 - Staff has commented on consultant's fish relocation plan, which is required by United States Forest Service (USFS)
 - Staff is working on updating regulatory applications for Fall 2021 or Fall 2022 construction
- g. Future Waterlines
 - Survey for Pioneer Trail and Herbert Walkup Waterline Projects is proceeding
 - Staff will begin design of Pioneer Trail Waterline on August 23
- h. Water System Asset Management Projects
 - Water Station Backup Power
 - Application for FEMA Mitigation Funds for a backup generator for Al Tahoe/Bayview
 Wells being recommended by Office of Emergency Services (OES) to FEMA
 - Water Crossings Condition Assessment
 - See Sewer Crossings Condition Assessment
 - Cathodic Protection Pilot Study
 - Consultant submitted proposal for soil and continuity testing of three potential project areas, but not funded in Fiscal Year 2022
 - Shelve until Spring
- i. Sewer System Asset Management Projects
 - WWTP Condition Assessment (Consultant: Water Systems Consultants)
 - Structural field assessments completed late July/early August
 - Staff reviewing proposals for underground piping assessment
 - Consultant preparing recommendations for further electrical testing
 - Sewer Station Electrical Condition Assessments: Consultant preparing recommendations for further electrical testing
 - Recycled Water Strategic Plan (Consultant: TBD)
 - Carollo selected after July 12 interviews
 - Plan to bring recommendation to Board on September 2

- Sewer Crossings Condition Assessment (Consultant: Cardno)
 - Consultant is reviewing District information and developing priority list for field work
 - Scheduled to begin after Labor Day
 - Underground Repair Sewer (URS) is currently performing Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) of accessible sewer crossings

OTHER

- a. Tahoe Keys Emergency Supply
 - Intertie is open, but no flow
 - Backflow assembly has not yet been installed at intertie
 - As of August 9:
 - Reimbursement Agreement has not yet been approved by Tahoe Keys Board
 - Request for Proposal (RFP) is being reviewed based on Tahoe Keys comments
 - Issuance on hold pending Tahoe Keys Board approval (next meeting August 16)
- b. Water Audit
 - Staff submitted Annual Water Audit to the state in late July
- c. WWTP Solar Project
 - Ad Hoc Committee meeting scheduled for August 16
 - Staff presentation and Letter of Intent to Board on August 19
 - Staff expects to bring Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) to Board for consideration in September
- d. Staffing Update
 - New Part-Time Contracts Helper started August 10
 - Staff is preparing request for extension of Limited Term Project Coordinator until June 2024
 - Expect to bring request to Board in September
